If you are interested in applying for the Federal Perkins Loan or Federal Work-Study please complete this form and return it to Sherill Ashe, Division of Graduate Medical Sciences, 74 East Concord Street , Room L 315, Boston, MA 02118. To be eligible for the Federal Perkins Loan or Federal Work-Study you must:

- ◆ Complete a 2009-2010 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
- ◆ Submit the Federal Funds Request Form
- ◆ Submit 2008 Federal Income Tax Return
- ◆ Be enrolled in a degree program on a full-time basis
- ◆ Be registered with Selective Service
- ◆ Be a US Citizen or permanent resident

Federal Perkins Loan

The Federal Perkins Loan offers students who demonstrate need a low, 5% loan. The Federal Perkins Loan is not a grant or scholarship and does have to be repaid. The average award is \$2,000.00.

Federal Work-Study Program

The Federal Work-Study Program allow students to work at Boston University or a non-profit agency while enrolled in a degree program. Work-Study is not a grant or a loan. Students may work a maximum of 20 hours/week and is paid on a weekly basis. Students' earnings must not exceed their Work-Study award. The average award is \$3,500.00.
